Why We Collect Personal Information

We collect PII (Personally Identifiable Information) and other information only as necessary to administer our programs. The information you provide will be used only for that purpose. We do not sell the information collected at this site or any other information we collect.

What Personal Information We Collect

When you visit the FPB website, you do so anonymously. There is no need to reveal your identity. You do not have to give us personal information to visit our website.

If you direct an inquiry to an FPB department, we will ask you to provide your name, mailing address, phone number, account number, or email address for the purpose of responding to your inquiry. Only those who "need to know" will have access to the personal information provided.

When you complete online transactions, job applications, or enter online surveys or contests we may collect personal information such as your name, address, phone number, account number, and/or e-mail.

Providing the requested information implies your consent for us to use this data in order to respond to your specific request.

What Session Information We Collect

FPB websites log the date and time of the visit, the web pages or services accessed, the type of browser and operating system and the IP address of all site visitors. An IP address is the number automatically assigned to the computer or to the ISP (Internet Service Provider) that is requesting a website content page.

We use IP addresses to analyze trends, administer the site, track visitors' movements and gather broad demographic information for aggregate use. Information is also collected for the purpose of assessing system performance, improving web services and web site management. IP addresses are not linked to



personally identifiable information.

Some of the services available from FPB websites may require the use of "cookies". FPB websites uses "per-session" cookies only.

Per-session cookies are small files that are temporarily stored in your computer's memory and are deleted when you leave FPB websites.
